### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



Brothers and Sisters,

As the IBEW 160 teams together with our partnering locals to negotiate the general contract with Xcel Energy (the largest utility contract we negotiate) I write to share my opinion on this matter.

The Union spends a tremendous amount of time evaluating and prioritizing the information that you and the other members send them via the information cards that are returned to the Hall before the negotiations ever begin. This includes the comments placed on the bottom of the cards, too. I get a lot of questions and comments from the field from members stating, "You guys don't read those cards and don't take into account what's returned". My response to those individuals is this, "All

of the cards are read, even the ones that are not always the most positive. We need that information to move forward. Without it, we would be negotiating blindly and that, my friends, isn't how we operate collectively".

Although we send out the info cards hoping for a substantial return, that's not generally the reality. There's also no reason the members don't respectfully voice their concerns and wants at the general membership meetings as that is what they are for.

As I've stated previously, we, your elected officials, work for you, the members. I once again want to state that the membership is what makes up IBEW 160 - the Union we proudly represent. Without your voice and input on vital topics, we can only represent you to the best of our ability. Membership meetings aren't always about the negative things that are evolving in the field, we need to hear about the positive ideas that you all have too. ### **BY THE NUMBERS:**

- Missouri Valley currently has 754 Line Apprentices
- 5 apprentices out of work due to material shortages
- Of those 754, 100 are Local 160 hands
- 39 Substation Apprentices total
- 15 URD Technicians total
- 4 Cable Splicing Technicians total
- 16 Operating Apprentices

For a grand total of 828 Apprentices and Trainees.

### NEWS:

The JATC is starting a four year, 7,000 hour Department of Labor Cable Splicer Apprenticeship. This will help man the work in our seven state area so that we do not lose the work to non-union contractors. If you have any questions about the program please contact the Mo Valley office. We have just closed on the purchase of 50 acres next door to our property. This allows the JATC the ability to expand when needed and prevents us from becoming landlocked in the future. That puts our total foot print at 100 acres.

#### **REMINDER:**

We would like to encourage all of our apprentices and trainees to attend Mo Valley Unit union meetings when possible. You don't have to attend all of them; we know that people's lives are busy and that plans constantly change. However, you should try and make it to a few union meetings each year. The meetings are a great place to connect with other members, hear news and updates about current work, ask any questions that you may have about working conditions and to be involved with your local. The best way to know what's going on, get questions answered, share positive feedback or address concerns is to attend a union meeting. Be sure to bring a current dues receipt to get into the meetings.

#### SAFETY:

Worker safety is priority number one...ALWAYS. There have been several instances of workers having electrical contact incidents in the last quarter while working on distribution lines in Mo Valley's jurisdiction involving digger derricks. I would like to remind everyone that if there is an electrical contact involving a worker (as soon as the scene has been made safe) activate Emergency Medical Service (EMS) by calling 911 and specifically state that the victim needs to be evaluated by a specialists in the field of electrical burns or electrical contact. The difficulty with electrical contact is that while on the job, you cannot be certain of the severity of injuries so you must contact EMS immediately then they can professionally assess the victim. A prompt response helps the victim. Remember to use your cover up and keep your head on a swivel.
